SME ADVICE UNIT SET UP

Dunkerque-Port, the Cité des Entreprises ("Business City"), the Nord-Pas de Calais Logistics and Transport Club and the Regional Customs Departments of Lille and Dunkirk signed an agreement on 25 June in the presence of the Interregional Customs Director and the President of the Maritime and Commercial Union of Dunkirk.

The agreement has enabled the creation of an advice unit for SMEs within the Cité des Entreprises.

The role of the Customs-Port unit is to assist businesses, through specialist organisations, in their formalities for obtaining deferred payment of VAT at import. It will inform them of the service offers in sea and overland transport in the Port of Dunkirk, and promote contacts with port professionals.
